Animal Control Ordinance July 7, 2015

Title

This Ordinance shall be titled Town of St. James Animal Control Ordinance dated July 7, 2015.

Authority. North Carolina General Statute 160A-174 delegates authority to towns, to regulate by ordinance, conditions detrimental to the health, safety, or welfare of its citizens and the peace and dignity of the town, and to define and abate nuisances; and, North Carolina General Statute 160A-186 grants authority to towns to regulate domestic animals.


Purpose. The Town Council for the Town of St. James desires to provide sufficient and adequate protection to all of its citizens.

Article 1. The Town Council for the Town of St. James North Carolina, hereby adopts the Brunswick County Animal Control Ordinance in its entirety, and thereby authorizes the Brunswick County Sheriff Department, Animal Services Division jurisdiction within the Town of St. James for enforcement of the Brunswick County Animal Control Ordinance.

Article 2. All dogs and cats must have attached to their collars, owner identification information. Such information shall include telephone number(s) and a local address. Failure to attach this information shall be a violation of this Ordinance.

This Ordinance shall take effect on this the 7th day of July, 2015.
